## **GOLF TOURNAMENT NEESE'S SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Page Alumni and Friends Association Scholarship Committee was given the opportunity to carry out the selection process for the Pirates. They were charged with selecting a female and male senior athlete that best exemplified "team before self." This year's committee – Jay Hitchcock ('96), David White ('76), and Stephanie Dingman Keaney ('93) – had their work cut out for them, as the candidate pool was quite impressive. In the end, Grace D'Englere and Rodger Shull were selected as the Page Pirate 2010 winners.

Soccer player **Grace D'Englere** was nominated by Coach Zack Osborne. He was impressed by her commitment to her sport as well as to her team. He described her as very coachable, a player who handled difficult situations with "class and a lot of courage." Grace, a center defender, went from JV her freshman year to All-Conference as a sophomore. She is respected by her teammates because she is approachable and extremely levelheaded. Coach Osborne feels she is a top-level representative of Page High School.

Track team member **Rodger Schull** demonstrated "team before self" at several meets by giving up his spot to run an individual event in order to run a relay for his team. His hard work has helped him cut his mile time down by well over a minute.
